## Transportation and Accommodations

The campus is situated approximately 0.5 km from Jay Prakash Narayan International Airport and about 8 km from Patna Junction Railway Station, 10 km from Rajendra Nagar Terminals, 7 km from Danapur and 4 km from Patliputra Railway Station, facilitating convenient access for delegates. The organising committee will arrange local transportation for delegates from place of arrival to the place of their stay and to the conference venue. Similarly, the local transport for daily movement and the return journey of the delegates will also be arranged.

Accommodation for delegates will be arranged in government guest houses (BASU, ICAR, BAMETI, etc.) and private hotels located in the vicinity of the conference venue, subject to prior request and availability. Tariff rates for private hotels are expected to start from approximately Rs. 2,000 per day onwards, depending on the category of accommodation and amenities provided. Delegates are advised to communicate their accommodation requirements well in advance to facilitate necessary arrangements.

management of companion animals.

## Mode of Presentation
